### Preparation of ESGF F2F in Washington (04 - 07.12.18)

The European contribution counts to 17 presentations out of 41 completed by 4 posters and structuring the complete session "Rethinking ESGF Architecture"

We agreed on three action items

## C4impact problems:

- Back online now, hosted on cloud resources
- → such problems should be communicated early in DTF
- → monitoring, status page would be useful
- No objections to advertise C4I portal as alternative CMIP6 data access interface even for a specific user community, the climate impacts scientists

#### Ec-earth node problems

- Issue with necessary old cmip5 data unpublication
- CMIP6 plans for EC-earth?
- Action: Start Discussion with EC-Earth (Sebastien)
- Future Action (IS-ENES3): include in ENES strategy how to deal with such problems
